## Tree Species Survey 2017/2018 – Ham Lane Bridleway

Ham Lane Bridleway runs alongside Ham Lane. Tree belts run either side of the Bridleway and consists of 84 canopy trees. The dominant species is field maple, but you will also find many ash and oak trees. Look closely and you will find limes, birches, Scots pine, alder and even a sweet chestnut. The understory is made up of hazel, elder, hawthorn with many self-set sycamores that will in time join the canopy trees.
