Horse Riding Guidelines

We want every visit to the Park to be safe, fun and enjoyable for everyone. To help make that happen, please take a moment to follow a few simple guidelines while you're riding:

- Most of the horse routes in Nene Park are open thanks to the kind permission of local landowners, and they're used for recreation or agriculture. Let's all show respect for the space and each other.
- If you're riding within the Park, or exploring beyond it, we suggest using this leaflet alongside the Ordnance Survey 1:25,000 Explorer 277 Map of Peterborough to help plan your route.
- Ride safely - plan ahead, follow the signs and stick to the marked horse routes. Ride quietly when passing other visitors or livestock.
- Be considerate - keep an eye out for other Park users, leave gates and property as you find them and take any litter home or use the bins provided.
- Some areas may flood at times. Please check with Nene Park Trust for updates and avoid any waterlogged sections. For horses or ponies who are unsure of water, note that there are two fords on the route to Castor.
