

Fishing at Ferry Meadows

Ferry Meadows has been recognised as one of the best fishing waters in the East Midlands and East Anglia and is popular with anglers from all over the country.

The fishing concession on the River and Lakes in the Park is operated by the Peterborough and District Angling Association (P&DAA).

The two main lakes, Gunwade and Overton are connected to the River Nene and contain a wide range of fish species including **carp, tench, chub, bream, roach, rudd, perch and pike**.

To fish these waters you will need a rod licence, available online from gov.uk or from the Environment Agency on 0344 8005386. A day ticket is available from the P&DAA online.

On Arrival

Please park your car in one of the designated car parks. Daily parking charges apply at Ferry Meadows car parks. An annual parking membership is available.

The road leading into the Park is locked at night. Opening and closing times are displayed on the notice board by the barrier at the start of the road. Alternatively see our website for more details.

Fishing is limited to Gunwade and Overton Lakes and the River. Fishing is not allowed in the smaller Lynch Lake.

There is no need to report to anybody, just set yourself up and the P&DAA Bailiff will visit you on the bank.

Accessible Angling

There are accessible fishing pegs situated near Lakeside car park. Mobility scooters are available at the Visitor Centre, free of charge. Call us on 01733 234193 to reserve yours.

Season Dates

Fishing on Gunwade and Overton Lakes in Ferry Meadows is available all year round. Fishing on the river is **only** permitted from 16 June to 14 March (inclusive)

Charges

Day tickets and seasonal memberships are only available to purchase online. To get your tickets in advance go to: www.fishinginpeterborough.co.uk

Day tickets: £5 adults, £3 seniors aged 65yrs+ and free for juniors 0-16yrs.

Seasonal membership: £15 adults, £15 seniors 65yrs+ and free for juniors 0-16yrs.

- No live baiting
- Leave no litter and don't discard line or tackle
- Do not remove any bank protection
- Night fishing is for night permit holders only. Please contact P&DAA.
